



### **NOTE to Facilitator:**

Congratulations for stepping out and willing to facilitate discussion with your Middle School or Junior High Faith Club. The first tip is this. IT's EASY! All you have to do is read and follow this guideline below. Blessings and God Speed! One last tip. It's all about participation. Encourage everyone to share in the small groups. (Groups size can be anywhere from 4-8 kids in a group).

**Opening Prayer:** Dear Jesus, you are the perfect example of what human living should look like because as God you became a human being. Help us to become more like you so that the world can know what you look like. When the world is broken and destructive help us to be kind, compassionate, and forgiving with one another.

### **Topic: Christian Living**

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 4:29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. 30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 31 Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. 32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

### **Discussion Questions:**

1. Who is the best example of a good person that you know of in your life? And Why?
2. When was a time when someone said hurtful things towards you?
3. How are people angry, cruel, or bitter in our schools?
4. What is one kind thing could you do for a classmate today?

**Closing Prayer:** God, you are good even when we may not be. You are faithful to us, even when we may not be towards you. But because you are kind towards us when we don't do the things you may want us to, we are given grace every day. Help us to show that same kindness towards others, when they aren't being kind to us, our friends, and our classmates. Thank you for forgiving us and help us to do the same for others.
